The pumpkin, laden with personal significance, becomes a motif through which Kusama communicates her emotions, notably revealing her capacity to express love. The striking interplay of yellow and black within the artwork creates a captivating and intense color contrast, asserting its visual dominance. The meticulous arrangement of these elements not only adds visual complexity but also imparts a sense of depth and texture, contributing to the essence of Kusama's artistic vision. That is Self-Obliteration." This process of assimilation, demonstrated through the integration of dots into various forms, serves to dissolve boundaries between the object and its surroundings.

草间弥生与南瓜的深厚渊源源于她童年时从幻觉中获得的慰藉,这在 这部杰出的作品中得到了雄辩的表达。 南瓜充满了个人意义,成为草 间弥生传达情感的主题,特别是揭示了她表达爱的能力。 艺术品中黄 色和黑色的惊人相互作用创造了迷人而强烈的色彩对比,彰显了其视 觉主导地位。 这些元素的精心排列不仅增加了视觉的复杂性,而且赋 予了深度感和质感,有助于体现草间弥生的艺术视野的精髓。 这就是 自我消除。"这种同化过程通过将点整合成各种形式来展示,有助于 消除物体与其周围环境之间的界限。



Provenance 来歴 : Christie's Hong Kong: Sunday, May 30, 2010 [Lot 01115] I Nyoman Masriadi is an outstanding artist from the late Suharto era in Indonesia. His works draw inspiration from the narratives of Indonesian culture and history. Since 2000, his creative style has gradually shifted towards a focus on singular figures, incorporating elements from comics, resulting in peculiar and intriguing pieces. Dramatic elements, a sense of provocation, black humor, and eloquent language have consistently been notable features in his works.

The artwork featured in this auction is part of Masriadi's renowned "Man from Bantul" series. The boxer in the painting raises both fists, preparing for a boxing training session, and his gaze reflects unwavering determination. The dialogue box in the upper left corner adds curiosity about the story behind the painting, stating, "I recently achieved success through boxing, and I used it to buy a pair of boxing gloves."

This piece was exhibited in 2008 at the National University of Singapore (NUS) Museum, as part of an exhibition covering works from fourteen contemporary Indonesian artists. The exhibition delves into the impact of reality on the language and values of art, starting from Sudjojono's advocacy of Indonesian nationalism and revolutionary aesthetics in the mid-20th century.

I Nyoman Masriadi是印度尼西亞後蘇哈托時期的 傑出藝術家。他的作品以印尼文化曆史故事爲靈 感,自2000年開始,他的創作風格逐漸演變爲以 單一人物爲主體,吸收了漫畫的元素,使作品充 滿了怪誕和趣味。作品中的戲劇性、挑釁感、黑 色幽默和精彩的語言一直是他作品中不可忽視的 特徵。

此次拍賣的作品是Masriadi最具代表性的Man from Bantul繫列之一。畫中的拳擊手舉着雙拳, 準備進行拳擊訓練,眼神中透露着堅毅的意誌。 而左上方的對話框更增添了人們對這幅畫背後故 事的好奇心: "我最近通過拳擊獲得了一些成 功,我用它來買了一副拳擊手套。"這引髮了對 畫外故事的深入思考。

該作品曾於2008年在新加坡國立大學博物館展 出,該展覆蓋了十四位印尼當代藝術家的作品。 展覽從蘇喬喬諾在20世紀中期提出的印尼民族主 義和革命美學的理想主義開始,呈現了現實對藝 術語言和價值觀的深刻影響。

Lee Man Fong's artistic creations can be broadly categorized into two styles. One focuses on portraits or landscapes, leaning towards a Western traditional oil painting style, signed with the English initials "MF Lee." The other style features animals native to Bukit Timah in Singapore, reflecting an Eastern influence with Chinese ink painting techniques. In this style, he signs his name in Chinese characters, " 曼峰," accompanied by a seal. The showcased Oleg dance, a classic representation of the artist's

Western style, portrays a poised and vibrant female dancer. Oleg, a Balinese dance designed by Westerners in the early 20th century, is described as one of the liveliest, humorous, and charming dances in Balinese repertoire. The historical context, along with Lee Man Fong's use of traditional techniques in creating this artwork, cleverly achieves a fusion of East and West.

李曼峰的創作大體可以分爲兩種風格,一種 是以人物肖像或者風景爲主,偏向西方式的 傳統風格油畫,落款為英文的MF Lee。而另 一種則是以畫家後期在新加坡武吉知馬當 地動物爲主, 融入中國水墨畫法的東方風格 繪畫, 落款漢字 "曼峰" 兩字, 配以蓋章。而 此時上拍的奧列舞則正是畫家經典的西方 風格繪畫。表現了一位泰然自若的女舞者 生動的形象。作爲20世紀初期由西方人設 計的巴厘舞蹈 oleg, 被描述爲 "巴厘島劇目 中最活潑、幽默和迷人的舞蹈之一",其曆史 與採用了傳統技法繪製該作品的李曼峰,何 尝又不是巧妙起到了一種東西交融的互文 效果呢。



In the 1960s, AY-O, driven by an experimental spirit, engaged in exploratory ventures in painting and installation art. His sharp criticism of civilization and avant-garde artistic forms made him a member of the Gutai movement, a movement transcending traditional boundaries that encompassed musicians, poets, and artists. This exploration peaked during his "Rainbow Artist" phase, where he deconstructed lines in painting and gave birth to an art form symbolized by the visible light spectrum from red to purple.

The exhibited works interpret the movements of pole-vaulters in vibrant rainbow hues. AY-O dissected the leaping action, surpassing static representations in traditional painting, and ultimately transformed the dynamics into a spherical form. The entire composition exudes a futuristic atmosphere, with dazzling rainbow colors and the energetic leap radiating a rare vitality.

20世纪60年代, AY-O秉持著實驗精神, 在繪畫以及裝置等領域進行實驗性的探 索。他對文明的尖銳 批判和前衛的藝術形式也讓他成為激浪派的一員。激浪派 是一場超越傳統界限、涵蓋音樂家、詩人 和藝術家的運動。這種探索在他的「 彩虹藝術家」階段達到頂峰, 他解構了繪畫中的線條, 并以從 紅色到紫色的可 視光線, 也就是光譜的顏色作為標誌的藝術誕生了。



Xue Song is an important explorer of "85 Thoughts". Liu Kuo-sung is remembered as one of the founders in modern Chinese painting, regarded as "The Father of Modern Ink Painting".

He dedicated his life to ink painting and through dedication he reconstructed traditional techniques to invent entirely new non - traditional techniques that ushered in a new era of possibilities. This work depicts a corona, where the rarefied gaseous envelope the sun and other stars. It is only visible during a total solar eclipse and is seen as an irregularly shaped pearly glow surrounding the darkened disc of the moon. The stark contrast between dark and light areas enthral the viewer's senses, seemingly transporting one into outer space. Similarly, Liu Kuo-sung spent a long period of time contemplating space exploration while painting. The beauty of the final product showcases not only his mastery of his unique style, but also the hundreds of hours he spent on the painting.

He enrolled at the Beijing Academy of Fine Arts in 1958 and the Zhejiang Academy of Fine Arts in 1960. In 1978, he travelled to 13 African countries for sketch visits and paintings from this trip were compiled into a book. In 1982, his first solo exhibition at the Nanjing Museum caused a sensation. Due to his unique talented style and constant innovation, Shi Hu was once called "the painter of painters" and "China's Picasso,". However he did not care about these titles. He once said, "Some people say I have ideology, but I say I don't say I have ideology. I only have a heart that cannot be conquered!"

The launch of the Shi Hu Asian Tour Exhibition in the early 2000 stimulated his strong creativity. The passionate and painstaking creation produced a batch of masterpieces. 

10. Remedies for non-payment or failure to collect purchases

If any lot is not paid for in full and taken away in accordance with Conditions 8 and 9, or if there is any other breach of either of those conditions, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest as agent of the seller will, at its absolute discretion and without prejudice to any other rights it may have, be entitled to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:

- a) to proceed against the buyer for payment and/or damages for breach of contract:
- b) to rescind the sale of that or any other lots sold to the defaulting buyer at the same or any other auction;
- c) to resell the lot or cause it to be resold by public auction or private sale and the defaulting buyer will be liable to pay to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest any resulting deficiency in the 'total amount due' (after deduction of any part payment and addition of resale costs) and any surplus will belong to the seller.
- to remove, store and insure the lots at the expense of the defaulting buyer and, in the case of storage, either at 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest premises or elsewhere;
- e) to charge interest at a rate not exceeding 2% per month on the 'total amount due' to the extent it remains unpaid for more than 5 working days after the day of the auction:
- f) to retain that or any other lot sold to the same buyer at the same time or at any other auction and release it only after payment of the 'total amount due';

- g) to reject or ignore any bids made by or on behalf of the defaulting buyer at any future auctions or require and receive a deposit in an amount determined by 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest before accepting any bids in future;
- h) to apply any proceeds of sale then due or at any time thereafter becoming due to the defaulting buyer towards settlement of the total amount due and to exercise a lien on any property of the defaulting buyer which is in 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest possession for any purpose.

11. Legal Costs

The buyer shall be responsible for the payment of 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest legal costs calculated on the scale as between attorney and its own client incurred in the enforcement of 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest rights irrespective of whether 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest institute legal proceedings or not.

12. Liability of 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest and sellers

a) Goods auctioned are usually of some age. All goods are sold as it is with all faults and imperfections and errors of description. Illustrations in catalogues are for identification only. Buyers should satisfy themselves prior to sale as to the condition of each lot and should exercise and rely on their own judgement as to whether the lot accords with its description or not. Subject to the obligations accepted by 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest under this condition, neither the seller, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest, their servants or agents is/are responsible for errors of descriptions or for the genuineness or authenticity of any lot. No warranty whatsoever is given by 33 Auction and New Art Est-Ouest, its servants or agents, or any seller to any buyer in respect of any lot, and any express or implied conditions or warranties are hereby excluded.

b) Any lot which proves to be a 'deliberate forgery' may be returned by the buyer to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest within 21 days of the date of auction in the same condition in which it was at the time of the auction, accompanied by a statement of defects, the number of the lot, and the date of the auction at which it was purchased. If 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest is satisfied that the item is a 'deliberate forgery' and that the buyer has and is able to transfer a good and marketable tille to the lot, free from any third-party claims, the sale will be set aside and any amount paid in respect of the lot will be refunded, subject to the express condition that the buyer will have no rights or claims against 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest if: i) the description in the catalogue at the date of the sale was in accordance with the 'then generally accepted opinion, or ii) the only method of establishing at the date of publication of the catalogue that the lot was a 'deliberate forgery' was by means of a scientific process not generally accepted for use until after publication of the catalogue, or by a process which was unreasonably expensive or impractical.

c) A buyer's claim under this condition will be limited to any amount paid in respect of the lot and will not extend to any loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered, or expense incurred by him/her.

d) The benefit of this condition will not be assignable and will rest solely and exclusively in the buyer who, for the purpose of this condition, will be and only be the person to whom the original invoice is made out by 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest in respect of the lot sold.

Conditions mainly concerning sellers and consignors

13. Inspections

33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest shall inspect items brought to its offices or viewed at seller's domain for potential auction and will advise owners as to the value and suitability within the 33 Auction trade markets. Items of insufficient value or unsuitable for the auction trade must be collected within 5 working days after having being notified. Items not collected will be sold in terms of clause 25. The service is without charge, though in certain instances it may be necessary to charge out-of-pocket and travelling expenses where the seller is out of town. 33 Auction reserves the right to accept or reject any item not meeting 33 Auction's criteria for the auction trade markets.

14. Seller's commission

A seller's commission is payable by the seller on the hammer price for lots sold. It will be deducted from the sales proceeds to the seller.

15. Marketing Illustration

The seller agrees to have the items illustrated in the auction catalogue and agrees to pay the published rate of marketing illustration charge. 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest is authorised to feature item(s) as it deems fit, and the sellers shall not request for special featuring of his/her/its auction item(s).

16. Warranty of title and availability

a) The seller warrants to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest and to the buyer that he/she is the true owner of the property or is properly authorized by the true owner and is able to transfer good and marketable title to the property, free from any third-party claims.
b) The seller of any property not held by 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest on its premises or under its control, warrants and undertakes to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest and the

buyer that the property will be available and in deliverable state on demand of the buyer. c) The seller indemnifies 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest, their agents and the buyer against any loss or damage suffered by either in consequence of any breach of (a) or (b) above on the part of the seller.

17. Liability for Loss or Damage

a) Unless otherwise agreed with 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest in writing in accordance with paragraph (d), 33 Auction will assume liability for loss or damage to any item, commencing at the time that item is received by 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest and ceasing when (i) risk passes to the Buyer of the lot following its sale; (ii) for unsold lots, 45 days after the sale or when the lot is released to the Selfer (whichever is earlier)

b) The Seller agrees to pay a charge as a percentage of (i) hammer price if the property sells, or (ii) reserve price if the property fails to sell.

c) If any loss or damage should occur to the lot during the period identified in paragraph (a) above, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest liability to compensate the Seller in respect of that loss shall be limited to the amount set out in paragraph (b)(i) to (ii) as applicable, less Seller's commission and Expenses.

d) The Seller must agree with 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest in writing if it does not wish 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest to accept liability for loss or damage to any item delivered to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest and undertake to maintain insurance cover for the item until the Buyer has made payment for the item in full.

18. Reserves

The seller will be entitled to place, prior to the auction, a reserve on any lot, being the minimum hammer price' at which that lot may be treated as sold. A reserve once placed by the seller may not be changed without the consent of 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest. 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest may at its option sell at a 'hammer price' below the reserve, but in any such cases the sale proceeds to which the seller is entitled will be the same as they would have, had the sale been at the reserve. The auctioneer may open the bidding on any lot by placing a bid on behalf of the seller. The auctioneer may further bid on behalf of the seller, up to the amount of the reserve, by placing responsive or consecutive bids for a lot. The reserve, if any, on any one lot will not exceed the low estimate as published in the catalogue.

19. Authority to deduct commission and expenses

The seller authorizes 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest to deduct commission at the 'stated' rates, 'illustration' and 'expenses' from the 'hammer price' and acknowledges 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest right to retain the premium payable by the buyers in accordance with Condition 2.

20. Rescission of the sale

If before 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest remits the 'sale proceeds' to the seller, the buyer makes a claim to rescind the sale under Condition 12 or otherwise and 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest is of the opinion that the claim is justified, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest is authorized to rescind the sale and refund the buyer any amount paid to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest in respect of the lot.

21. Payment of sale proceeds

Subject to Condition 16 above, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will remit the 'sale proceeds' to the seller not later than 35 days after the date of auction, but if by that date 33 Auction has not received the 'total amount due' from the buyer, then 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will remit the 'sale proceeds' within 5 working days after the date on which the 'total amount due' is received from the buyer.

If the buyer fails to pay 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will endeavour to notify the selfer weeks after the auction, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will endeavour to notify the selfer and take the selfer's instructions as to the appropriate course of action and, so far as in33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest opinion it is practicable, will assist the selfer to recover the total amount due' from the buyer. If circumstances do not permit 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest to take instructions from the selfer, the selfer authorises 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest at the selfer's expense to agree special terms for payment of the total amount due', to remove, store and insure the lot sold, to settle claims made by or against the buyer on such terms as 33 Auction will in its absolute discretion think fit, to take such slopes as are exessary to collect the amount due by the buyer to the seller and if necessary to rescind the sale and refund money to the buyer. If, notwithstanding that the buyer fails to pay to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest the 'total amount due' within 3 weeks after the auction, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest the 'total amount due' within 3 weeks after the ownership of the lot shall pass to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest.

22. Charges for withdrawn lots

Where a seller cancels instructions for sale, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest reserves the right to charge both full buyer's premium and seller's commission on 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest middle estimate of the low and high estimates of the property withdrawn, together with 'expenses' incurred in relation to the property.

23. Rights to photographs and illustrations

The seller gives 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest full and absolute right to photograph, illustrate, or otherwise produce images, of any lot placed in its hands for sale and to use such photographs and illustrations and any photographs and illustrations provided by the seller at any time at its absolute discretion (whether or not in connection with the auction).

24. Provenance

In certain circumstances, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest may print in the catalogue the history of ownership of a work of art if such information contributes to scholarship or is otherwise well known and assists in distinguishing the work of art. However, the identity of the seller or previous owners may not be disclosed for a variety of reasons. For example, such information may be excluded to accommodate a seller's request for confidentiality or because the identity of oncr owners is unknown oriven the age of the work of art.

25. Unsold lots and uncollected items

33 Auction reserves the right to sell any unsold lot within 35 working days from the auction date, at the reserve price on behalf of the seller. Where any lot fails to sell after the above period, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Duest will notify the seller accordingly. Uncollected items not suitable for auction must be collected within 5 days after being notified of their unsuitability as per clause 13 and failing timely collection they will be dealt with on the basis set out in paragraph 25(c) below.

The selier must make arrangements either to re-offer the lot for sale or to collect the lot. If such arrangements are not made:

 a) within 7 days of notification, the seller will be responsible for any removal and storage expenses;

b) within 3 months of notification, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will have the right to sell the lot at public auction without reserve and to deduct from the 'hammer price' any sum owing to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest including (without limitation) removal, storage, commission at the stated rates, and other reasonable expenses before remitting the balance to the seller.

c) If 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Cuest is unable to sell the lot at a public auction as contemplated in paragraph 25(b) above then 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Cuest is entitled to sell the lot and any uncollected items without auction at the highest attainable price and to deduct from the selling price any sum owing to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Cuest including (without limitation) removal, storage, commission at the stated rate, and other reasonable expenses before remtiting the balance, it any, to the seller. Any shortfall which may be owing by the seller to 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Cuest consequent upon the seller's failure to collect the unsold lot shall be payable together with interest and legal costs on demand.

26. General conditions and definitions

33 Auction and/or New Art Esi-Ouest sells as agent for the seller (except where it is stated wholly or partly to own any lot as principal and such lots are identified by ◊ next to the lot number) and as such is not responsible for any default by seller or buyer.

27. Any representation or statement by 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest, in any catalogue, as to authorship, attribution, genuineness, origin, date, age, provenance, condition or estimated selling price is a statement of opinion only. Every person interested should exercise and rely on his/her own judgement as to such matters and neither 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest nor their servants or agents are responsible for the correctness of such opinions.

28. While the interests of prospective buyers are best served by attendance at the auction, 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will if so instructed execute bids on their behalf, neither 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest nor their servants or agents being responsible for any neglect or default in doing so or for failing to do so.

29. 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest will have the right, at its discretion, to refuse admission to its premises or attendance at its auctions by any person.

30. 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest has absolute discretion without giving any reason to refuse any bid, to divide any lot, to combine any 2 or more lots, to withdraw any lot from the auction and in case of dispute to put up any lot for auction again.

a) Any indemnity under these conditions will extend to all actions, proceedings, costs, expenses, claims and demands whatsoever incurred or suffered by the person entitled to the benefit of the indemnity.

b) 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Quest declares itself to be a trustee for its relevant servants and agents of the benefit of every indemnity under these conditions to the extent that such indemnity is expressed to be for the benefit of its servants and agents.

31. The parties choose domicilium citandi et executandi* at the addresses reflected on the face thereof. Any notice given in connection with this agreement may be delivered by hand; or be sent by prepaid registered post; or be sent by telefax or by email if the domicilium includes a telefax number and/or an email address, to the domicilium chosen by the party concerned. Any notice or process delivered on any party in connection with any matter or subject arising out of this agreement or any notice shall be deemed to have been delivered if handed to any responsible person at the domicilium chosen by any party and it shall not be necessary to hand such process or notice to any party personally.

A notice given as set out above shall be presumed to have been duly delivered:-

(i) on the date of delivery if delivered by hand or telefax or email;

(ii) on the fourth day from the date of posting including the date of posting if posted by pre-paid registered post from within the Republic of Singapore.

32. Every auction and all matters concerned therewith including these conditions, will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore and the buyer submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Singaporean courts.

33. In these conditions:

 a) 'catalogue' includes any advertisement, brochure, estimate, price-list, website content and other publication;

b) 'hammer price' means the price at which a lot is knocked down by the auctioneer to the buyer; c) 'total amount due' means 'hammer price' in respect of the lot sold together with any premium chargeable and additional charges and expenses due from the defaulting buyer under Condition 10;

d) a 'deliberate forgery' means an imitation made with the intention of deceiving as to authorship, origin, date, age, period, culture or source, which is not shown to be such in the description in the catalogue and which at the date of the sale had a value materially less than it would have had if it had been in accordance with that description;

e) 'sale proceeds' means the net amount due to the seller, being the 'hammer price' of the lot sold less commission at the 'stated rates', 'expenses' and any other amounts due to 33 Auction by the seller in whatever capacity and howsoever arising;

f) 'stated rates' means 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest published rates of commission for the time being;

g) 'expenses' in relation to the sale of any lot means 33 Auction and/or New Art Est-Ouest charges and expenses for illustrations, special advertising, packing and freight of that lot and any GST thereon.

34. Special terms may be used in catalogues in the description of the lot. Where terms are not self-explanatory and have special meanings ascribed to them, a glossary will appear before Lot 1 in the catalogue of the auction.
